REGISTRATION

- Registration for AA/A tryouts will open in early April
- Registration fees include:
 - Guaranteed two evaluated ice sessions this is inclusive of AA/A & Rep B tryouts
 - Tryout socks and jerseys

REGISTRATION

- Players are still considered registered as tryouts are taking place during 2024-2025 season
- Same process as registering for the season (Spordle/Hockey Canada Account)
- Select JRG Tryout Fee, proceed to payment options
- Fees must be paid prior to taking the ice;
 includes those returning from AAA tryouts
- Must register for the 2025-2026 season in June

ROSTERS

- Rosters can consist of 15-17 skaters and 2 goalies
- Should a player move into D12 district during the off-season, they will be given an opportunity to tryout for AA/A as part of the Rep B tryout process
- If a player earns an AA/A spot, they will be added to the roster. No players will be removed from the team that was set in the Spring.

SPRING TRYOUTS

AA/A

- Conditioning starts April 26
- Evaluations start May 2
- Expectation to end by May 16, but could go to May 18

Rep B

- Fall 2025
- Players can opt to only tryout for Rep B

PATHWAYS

Conditioning Session

- Hockey Canada Pathways requires players from U9-U15 have an opportunity to participate in conditioning sessions prior to being evaluated
- Players will be randomly assigned to conditioning sessions

Contact Clinic

 All players going into U14, and new players to Jr Grads from U15-U18 must do a contact clinics

Skills Evaluations

- U9-U11 are required to have skills evaluations prior to game play
- Players will be randomly assigned to a skills session

Game Play

- Game play will take the form of intrasquad and exhibition games
- Players will be assigned to games; not all players will play every game

EVALUATIONS

- Ir Grads will have an Evaluation Committee that may consist of third party evaluators, Ir Grads and CMHA team members, and the coaches
- Player evaluations will be based on skills, gameplay, team dynamics, hockey IQ coachability, and attitude

COACH SELECTIONS

- Over 45 coach applicants are being interviewed for 18 teams
- AA/A coaches will be named during the AA/A intrasquad games
- Rep B coaches will be named after the end of AA/A tryouts

COMMUNICATIONS

- Contact Convenor or Director of Competitive via email
- Do not engage the evaluators or coaches throughout tryouts
- Updates on dates, timelines and schedules will be made available on the CMHA website and via social media (FB and IG)

PROCESS

- First round releases will occur after the first Intrasquad session
- Players will continue to be released until the final roster is set following the last exhibition game
- Released players will be notified via email by the convenor with details on next steps.
- Players who are moving on with tryouts will be notified of next steps
- NO emails will be sent during school hours (between 7am and 4pm)


WHAT ARE NEXT STEPS IF RELEASED?


- Players will be moved to the Rep B tryout list
 - Players must keep their tryout a jersey. If it is lost over the summer, there will be a \$50 replacement fee.

TRYOUT TRANSFERS

- There are no General Releases
- Players must attend tryouts with their home association before submitting a Tryout Transfer
- Tryout Transfer is initiated by the Receiving Association, confirming they will allow the player to attend tryouts
 - Authorized by both District Chairs and Association Presidents/Directors
- Player who is released returns to CMHA (JRG Rep B/Dukes)
- Transfer is for one season only
 - Player returns to JRG tryouts next season
